Goods Inward

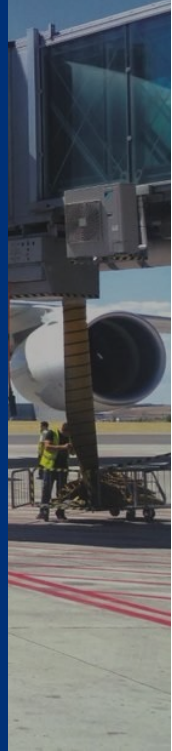
- Check and receive deliveries to site
